Re: Review of Electoral arrangements for the County of Anglesey

Valley Community Council have recently received a letter from Amlwch Town Clerk to draw our attention to a review of electoral arrangements for the County of Anglesey. Members of Amlwch Town Council are concerned that there is no intention to have an initial period of consultation at the start of the review, when there is a possibility that any change will have a significant effect on many areas across Anglesey and that the establishment of multi-member arrangements may be unfair in a rural area such as Anglesey.

As you are aware, draft proposals for changing local government boundaries in Anglesey have previously been circulated in January 2010, together with a letter requesting comments.

At that time, no public consultation with the population of Anglesey took place, despite the fact that recommendations made therein would significantly affect them in the future.

At that time a letter was sent to you by the Chairman of Valley Community Council to oppose the proposal to join Gorad Ward with

We are concerned about the reviewing arrangements which have been adopted on this occasion,. The tight timescale which has been set causes us to fear that the process will not be fair to all.

Valley members wish to ensure that the entire population of Anglesey receive fair and equitable representation in the future, with electoral boundaries which represent the population.

Consideration should also be given to holding a public consultation, which may require an extended timescale to ensure that there is time to undertake this.

Finally, the members of Valley Community Council would be pleased if you could confirm that the comments made in our previous letter, dated 2nd May 2010 will be duly considered on this occasion, as its contents are still relevant to any review taking place currently.
